20 FAM also defines over 30 other terms	 (1) Any artificial system that performs tasks under varying and unpredictable circumstances without significant human oversight, or that can learn from experience and improve performance when exposed to data sets.
associated with data.	 (2) An artificial system developed in computer software, physical hardware, or other context that solves tasks requiring human-like perception, cognition, planning, learning, communication, or physical action.
	 (3) An artificial system designed to think or act like a human, including cognitive architectures and neural networks.
	 (4) A set of techniques, including machine learning, that is designed to approximate a cognitive task.
	 (5) An artificial system designed to act rationally, including an intelligent software agent or embodied robot that achieves goals using perception, planning, reasoning, learning, communicating, decision making, and acting.


